It was able to increase access to comprehensive care while increasing pediatric immunizations and cervical cancer screening efforts. It also addressed coronary artery disease prevention efforts, further helping fill critical health care gaps within the communities it serves.

“It is a great honor to once again be recognized by the HRSA for the vital work CHI does in providing top quality health care services, especially when it comes to providing for our most vulnerable communities,” said CHI President and CEO Blake Hall. “These distinctions speak to the expertise and commitment of our skilled and devoted team of providers and caregivers who work tirelessly to give patients the treatment and care they need to complete the picture of an overall healthier community.”

Recognized for ranking in the top 21-30% in overall clinical performance among patient-centered medical homes (PCMHs) in the United States, CHI received an Access Enhancer accolade for increasing the number of patients served by 5%, and an Advancing Health Information Technology (HIT) for Quality distinction for optimizing use of the electronic health record to improve social determinants of health. Social determinants of health are the conditions in the places where people live, work and play that affect a wide range of health and quality of life risks and outcomes. HRSA awarded CHI based on a comparison of CHI's clinical quality measures to more than 1,400 other patient-centered medical homes throughout the United States.
